All cuts & claims during this period must be sent league wide via the
OFLpost@yahoo.com

From 7 PM PDT April 7th thru 7 PM PDT April 9th there exists a full 48-hour window of opportunity for teams to announce (via the OFLPost) their intention of claiming any available UFA (player not currently signed to an OFL contract, and who appears on the League file as a free agent).

Should two or more teams place a claim on the same player during that first 48-hour window the Draft Order from the just completed January Rookie Draft shall be used to award player to the team slotted earliest. Thereafter, all claims awarded on 1st come, 1st served basis.

Cuts of any player who appears on the disk (except the XX players) are eligible for claim 24 hours after their release on the OFLpost. This 24 hour waiting period provides a window of opportunity for all teams to become aware of a player's eligibility for claim. Once the 24 hours passes, its 1st come, 1st serve.

All claims during season must be signed to mandatory 1-year 50K contract. You don't have 1st refusal rights, they are automatically released after the season, returning to the rookie draft pool the next time they appear on Action disk.

Now is Primetime to brush up on the OFL's few, simple, Gameday Rules.... Review Pages 18 - 21

Often overlooked.... OFL has unique rule (see 2.A.II.3 on Pg 20) PROHIBITING QBs from re-entering game except for all other available QBs being injured/ejected. If your starting QB gets hurt, of course he can return to the game when available again. What you can't do is freely move between healthy available QBs throughout the game simply to take advantage of the QB with great rushing average on short yardage downs, the high percentage short passer on some, and the better long passer on still others.

Bench your QB, and he stays there until all other available QBs are either injured or ejected. Simple.

Rules for Playing & Reporting Weekly Games

Remember we're "behind by design" here in the OFL. The player disk we use is based on NFL 2007 Therefore, OFL games are played with Action 2008 – Be sure you installed the 12/03/08 Action Update

Foremost....We're here to enjoy some spirited fun. So keep it fun.

Be reasonable & flexible in your time frames to play Live games. If you know you'll need someone to coach your team the earlier in the week you solicit help, the better.

Win or lose, do it with grace. Report your games ASAP after completion. Karl works very hard to get the League file out promptly each week and deserves our cooperation to make his workload lighter.

Before Starting Game

Verify the rules settings are correct. If you don't toy with them, they should be fine. Verify both rosters are exactly 53 players and the ONLY de-activated players are the few Karl "created" (missed entire 2007 NFL season) and have the prefix "XX" before their last name. A new rule we just adopted prohibits us from selectively de-activating players until a team has either clinched their division or after week 14, which ever occurs first.

Playing Games

All games MUST be played as "**Scheduled League Game**". On game's main menu, click on "Play" in the uppermost left corner, drop down to "Scheduled League Game" & click on that. This automatically opens to the correct week of games.

Select your game from the list of games for that week, and click on the "Unplayed" to change it to "Play Next", then click on "Play" button near the upper right.

At the Pre Game Set menu, select "Expanded" Boxscore, verify correct Month & Stadium.

Game Over.... SEND in the Results!

At conclusion of game Zip your Game file, emailing it to the OFLPost@yahoogroups.com. The subject line of your Email with Zipped Game File should include:

Opponents, week, and whether or not there are carryover injuries. Examples:

Subject: Wk 1 NY@BUF - Carryover Injuries
or
Subject: BUF@SR Wk2 - No Injuries

Inside your email note the injured player(s) & length (this helps out Karl). Many coaches, in lieu of a brief game write-up prefer to paste the entire boxscore (which lists the injuries) and that is perfectly acceptable.

Coaches are encouraged to write something about the game, but at very least state the final score.

VERY IMPORTANT If game not played vs. Live opponent briefly explain circumstances because this year it may affect the money you/your opponent earn.

If you're unable/unwilling to play your opponent Live, make an effort to recruit someone to coach your team on your behalf. (And start that search early in the week, not Sunday night.) Failing that, send an email to the OFLPost stating your opponent should go ahead and play the game vs. your COA. You of course may email your opponent a new COA file specific for that game.

If game file is not received by weekly deadline, (Monday, 7 PM PDT), Statistician shall autoplay the game. Not much fun in that..... And it's gonna cost one or both teams valuable loss of bonus dollars.

Review Financial Structure in Constitution (pgs 14-18) for upcoming Bonus opportunities, season monetary awards and how Superstar salaries may be impacted (raised immediately) if dictated by player acquisitions. A player's Contract terms should always be weighed in valuing & determining trades.

Becoming an accomplished OFL Capologist is quintessential to building & maintaining a competitive franchise. A caveman can differentiate a 9 rated player is better than a 8, there's little skill in reaching that conclusion. The consistently better GMs appreciate that sometimes a 7 or even 6 rated player is a much better long term fit, especially if he's 5 years younger and on the rise, signed to a cap friendly standard OFL contract, with 3 years left before he hits free agency.

Minimum Roster Staffing Remainder of Season

Beginning Week 2, teams may opt to play a game with little or no depth at most positions, (and virtually all of us do when injuries take their toll), with the only staffing requirement after week 1 being teams must start each game with a minimum 2 QBs & 1 Kicker (either PK or Punter) active to play (not injured).

If you suffer carryover injuries to your QBs or Kickers that leave you short of this simple requirement you MUST cut someone and claim a player to comply with the mandate above.

The best time to do this is immediately after the game, because the requirement is fresh in your mind. If you fail to comply by the weekly MON 7 PM PDT deadline the Statistician shall do the required cut/claim on your behalf.

2009 OFL Constitution

Key Updates this year

Season Bonus Award now tied to playing games vs. Live opponents. This was overwhelmingly adopted by membership (18-2) with the intention of encouraging more games be played vs. another coach, and going so far as to accommodate another coach playing on behalf of someone who is unable to schedule that week.

Coaches no longer permitted to selectively de-activate players before games until they've either clinched their division or AFTER week 14, whichever ever occurs first. Three-quarters of the membership supported this in the 15-5 vote. The practice of de-activating less durable injury-prone players vs. weaker (or overwhelming) opponents to circumvent inconvenient injuries is history. Teams enjoyed 7 months during the off-season to build a roster to withstand the rigors of a 16-game OFL season, fully aware of the players & positions requiring additional depth & durability.

Anytime we do away with an ancient ritual there's a slow learning curve. Therefore, everyone should develop the good habit of reviewing both rosters at the start of games to insure no SELECTIVE de-activations have taken place. The players who missed all of NFL 2007 were "created" by Karl and appear with the prefix "XX" before their last name. Those players are ALWAYS inactive and should already appear as such on the weekly League file.

We just completed a 3rd change to OFL Life with the now mandatory cut-down to 53 players in March followed by a brief 10 day claim period. This amendment passed by an 18-2 margin. I believe it will prove to be a little change that pays big dividends on several fronts.

It will alter coaches' approach to the Supplemental Draft, ideally simplifying their instructions and limiting participation to the most coveted players left over. Reason being the warm body pickups can now be accomplished in the new 3rd Claim Period following the mandatory cut-down.

Getting all rosters down to 53 players (max.) the first week of March gives coaches, our DPP & Statistician more time to uncover the players that fell thru the cracks over the winter, and lessens that effort when final rosters come due a couple of weeks later.

It will provide teams with another venue for rounding out their roster depth without being forced into an unwise trade. Finally, it will allow teams to pickup a few players before the season and retain their all-important 1st refusal rights.

The 4th key change in 2009 (by slim 14-6 vote) we'll witness during Live Free Agent Bidding. Once a team passes on declaring a free agent up for bidding, they automatically pass in subsequent rounds. Either 1 of 2 results will occur. The process will be streamlined and a little less time consuming. Or, more teams will opt to participate. Either outcome is beneficial to the overall well being of the OFL. It's a win-win.

Appendix A – NON-BINDING guidelines to Expansion: While editing out a few redundant sentences in various sections of the Constitution this year I took the liberty to update Appendix A. Why? Because sooner or later we will discuss Expansion and Appendix A reflected the process when we went from 16 to 20 teams. A huge success by any subjective measurement. Expanding from 20 to 24 requires we tweak the procedure, from the number of players teams protect to addressing what we all learned when we handed out compensation dollars like the US Treasury.

Draft, Free Agency & Cut Claims clarified: Based on feedback received I split the Rookie Draft from Supplemental Free Agent Draft, and Live Bidding from Phase II Email Bids, into distinct sections. Tried to explain Claim process clearer, and emphasize that player contracts (beyond Superstar re-signings in Aug. & free agency bids in Oct.) are not assigned until March. Hopefully it all leads to broader understanding.

Rule Proposal... Or Better, Thinking Out Loud

Trying to build on the premise of the ill-fated reverse draft rule proposal, there is definitely merit in trying to find a way to have teams play hard throughout the season and not just roll over and have a very high draft pick. Another reason is to try and have a bit more parity in the OFL. It seems to me that there is a significant chasm between the haves and have nots and it does not seem to be shrinking.

The idea is relatively simple. Award the best non-playoff team with an additional pick at the end of round 1.

Pros

For me it would be an attractive incentive to pick up an extra first round pick.

Cons

I wonder if it is unfair to the teams that barely make the playoffs. Would they roll over instead of making the playoffs and being a sacrificial lamb? Is the first round pick too high? What about a #2 pick instead? Though is a #2 pick enough incentive?

To expand on this idea, the 2nd best non-playoff team would be awarded an extra #2 pick, the 3rd best non-playoff team an extra #3 pick and so on down to the 8th best non-playoff team being awarded an extra #8 pick (not very exciting I know <g>). The four worse non-playoff teams would get nothing though they would lock up high draft picks.

Other variations on this idea:

Addition to the above proposal - Have the four worse teams participate in a lotto to decide the top 4 picks. The lotto could be weighted or each team could have an equal chance. Now I'll duck for cover as for some reason lotteries are not well thought of in the OFL in spite of many other leagues using them ☺

Let the best non-playoff team cut any player on their team without any penalty. This could either include Superstars or not depending on the thoughts of the OFL membership. The questions are pretty much the same as above. Is this enough incentive? Is this too much incentive?

Final Thoughts

Who knows? Maybe something mentioned above would reduce the disparity between the haves and have nots? Maybe the above is severely flawed? Maybe the system that we have is as good as it gets? Maybe the above can be used as a building block for something better? Or maybe you're picking up a building block and tossing it my way?

The Other 'OFL'..... My First Year in Odyssey Football League By- Mike Jaime

For longest time I've sought a format to enjoy playing with NFL heroes from the bygone era when carnivores like Ben Davidson openly stalked Len Dawson, Dick Butkus boasted of coming away from the pile with Johnny Unitas' head. Bullet Bob Hayes, Homer Jones & Lance Alworth put the s-t-r-e-t-c-h in stretching the defense from Mad Bombers like Daryle Lamonica, Roman Gabriel & Jack Kemp. An era where Purple People Eaters' coach Bud Grant scoffed at sideline heaters on the frozen tundra of Bloomington or Lambeau.

There were no 'me-first' sack dances or endzone circus acts. Reveling in the moment was a simple slap on the teammate's ass, or players firing up a Lucky Strike along the sidelines. Team victories were the lone cause for celebration. And that was done the old-fashioned way; players went out all night and got hammered!!! Broadway Joe owned a nightclub frequented by underworld figures. Golden Boy turned Playboy, Paul Hornung, wagered on blondes & football games. Max McGee played his best football with a hangover. Booze 'n Broads were never more in vogue in the NFL than the 1960s & early 70s. Even CBS announcers Pat Summerall & Tom Brookshire were snogged during most broadcasts. Gosh, I miss it!

Last summer while scouring the various Action Leagues I came across the [Odyssey Football League](#). They had begun with the 1960 season and were now starting 1965. It seemed to offer most of what I sought: A simple keeper format, with minimal mandatory cut-down, basic 8 round draft. Most attractive, it's comprised of 20 teams when the combined NFL & AFL totaled only 24. (Before 1966 season that figure was 22 teams.)

That transpires to many teams having some starters rated 4 & 5. In this run to daylight era, no one enjoys the luxury of having several 70+reception receivers. If your 2nd best WR has about 35 catches, count your fortunes. Adding to the challenge, and this number will shock many of you- Odyssey rosters are comprised of just 42 players!

An opening existed last summer but they were literally days away from their 1965 rookie draft and I was simply ill prepared to take the plunge. I did not own the required disks and they play 2 seasons a year, starting in August & February. No way could I commit the time required so I passed on the opportunity.

I bookmarked their website and kept tabs over the coming months. In December having already decided to retire from my only other league at the time (TDFL) I wrote commissioner Brandon Rose requesting to be placed on the waiting list. The wait was over quickly, when within a week I was awarded a franchise: San Francisco 49ers. The 1966 rookie draft was only 3 weeks away and I needed to be prepared.

One would think drafting in a retro league is easy because we already know what a player did his entire career. Well, on that point- yes, it's "easy". On the other hand, try researching the entire careers of 160 players!! I quickly realized an investment into the Complete 1960s Decade that Dave Koch offers on a single disk was required. (Soon I plan to purchase the Complete 1970s Decade Disk.)

I inherited a good team equipped with the all-important "triplets" in place: John Brodie at QB, Gale Sayers at RB & Lance Alworth at WR. No 1st round pick (that had been traded away before I joined) so I set my sights on making my 2nd & 3rd rounders worthy. Conducted entirely by email over a one week period I was happy to land two long term offensive players with those first couple of picks in [RB Pete Banaszak](#) & [TE Tom Mitchell](#).

We're completing week 7 of the 1966 season. Midway of our 14-game schedule. My 49ers have managed a 4-3 record. The learning curve has led to 2 of those losses. You must erase the mindset of a modern coach. It's challenging to drive the ball 60, 70, 80 yards consistently in this era. Field Goal attempts are an adventure from any distance. Ball security is hazardous with the wide-open style passing prevalent in the old AFL. Compounding that, offensive holding costs 15 yards in this glorious age. Lack of depth & meaningful players limits situational substitution on defense. You play your 4-3 most of the time. A nickel now & again. Dime defense is rare. Forget the quarter, as most teams don't have the DB depth on their roster.

I've yet to transact my first trade, and league-wide my initial impressions are there're not a whole lot of them. Rebuilding appears to be brutal if one allows their franchise to fall too far behind. I'm looking forward to the 1967 draft if for nothing else I have all my draft picks, though I tried to tempt the Jets' Dave Pittner into swapping me Don Maynard for SF's 1st. I have the Colts' Willie Richardson on my roster. His 63 receptions in '67 to pair with Alworth should leave me thankful Dave did not take me up on my offer.

Thus far it's been fun. Some OFLers are also among the Odyssey coaching ranks. Of course Pete The Golden Greek is here. Pete's Steelers won the inaugural 1960 season Championship. Dave Pittner coaches the NY Jets. (Ironically about 1 week after I joined Odyssey, Dave joined the OFL.) Ex-OFLer Tony Fenton (former coach of the Florida franchise before Jim Heaton took over) is also here. This week Frank Aluzzi took over the Oakland Raiders following the abrupt resignation of their coach.

Pittsburgh 2009 Outlook

Quarterback- For many years, Pittsburgh had great stability at Quarterback, first Jim Kelly and when then when he retired Mark Brunell. For the last few years, Pittsburgh has been searching for a top signal caller and this year is no different. Pittsburgh will be playing with three quarterbacks waiting for someone to seize the reins. First up will be the injury prone Matt Schaub followed by Shaun Hill who is accurate with the short pass but can't throw long to save his life. The third quarterback is journeyman Chris Redmon, The short-range outlook is good for this year but long term, and a fix is needed.

Running Back- Amazingly, Clinton Portis went thru free agency last year without getting a bid. At the time, he was the leading rusher in football but he dropped off in the second half of last year. D'Angelo Williams first two years in the pro ranks were excellent and he'll be a solid compliment to Portis. Chris Brown and Kenton Keith fill out the running backs and both will be released in August but for this year they will fill out a good running game.

Wide Receivers- The first two receivers are excellent. Reggie Wayne and long target Lee Evans are as good as anyone. Kelvin Curtis and Ron Curry were both drafted five years ago and this looks like their peak years. Curtis is more of a long threat and Curry will move the sticks. Next year, this area will be looked upon as definitely needing depth.

Tight End- Dallas Clarke is the starter here. He is more of an H-Back than a tight end, but he's a good third down receiver when you need a first down. He'll be backed up by career backup Steve Heiden and blocking tight end Jason Dunn.

Defensive Line- Andre Carter and Will Smith bookend at defensive end with Tommie Harris and Vince Wilfolk clogging the middle. They are backed up by Rocky Bernard and Brett Keisel.

Linebackers- EJ Henderson was obtained in a big mid season trade for quarterback Damon Huard and he'll fill a big role as Middle Linebacker in the Assassin defense. At outside linebacker Greg Ellis and David Thornton will start. This is the position with the most depth as Joey Porter was acquired via waiver claim and other depth is provided by Clint Ingram, Jonathon Vilma and up and coming Lawrence Timmons.

Secondary- This is probably Pittsburgh's strongest secondary ever. At cornerback, the starters are Ronde Barber and Marcus Trufant. At safety, the starters are Troy Polamalu and Jermaine Phillips. Solid depth is provided by Ike Taylor and Sean Taylor.

Special Teams- Everybody has changed from last year's special teams and there is an upgrade everywhere. Jeff Reed is now the place kicker and Ben Graham the punter. Josh Cribbs was acquired for a third round pick, combine him with Dante Hall and the return teams look awesome.

Division Outlook- It looks like a three team race for first place between Baltimore, Las Vegas and Pittsburgh. 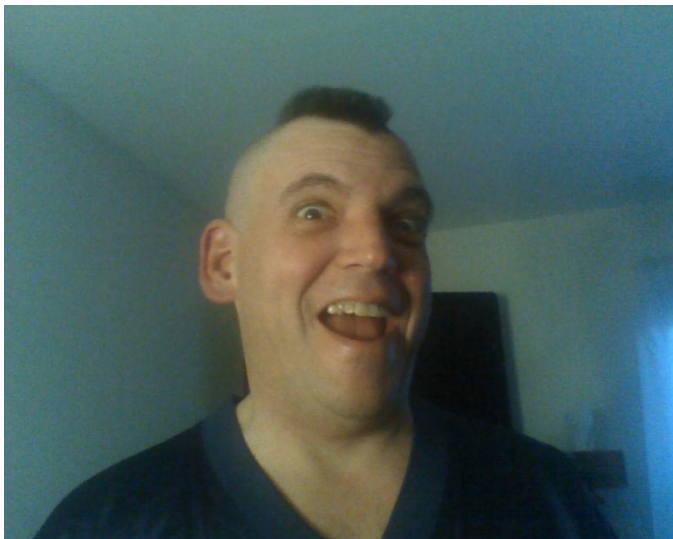

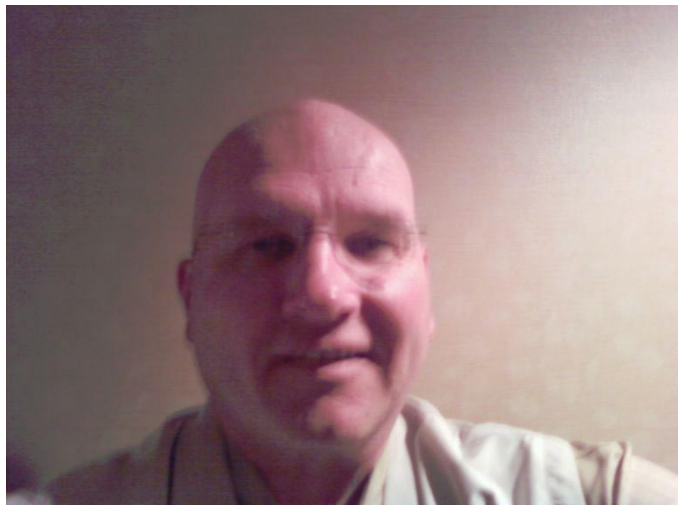
